



1716 town authorized building. Building cost 23 pounds and was completed in 1725. Located at 102 Union St. 1952 donated to PHS by the Halls.



Simple post and beam construction. Original frame is intact, but the outside has been restored in 1969 and 2000.



Entryway added when school moved to W.Main and Union. You can see type of lunch pail they would have used.



School bells came from McCorrie and Bristol Ferry Schools. Portsmouth later had a system of 8 one room schools.



This corner desk was original furniture in the school. Other desks came from other schools.
