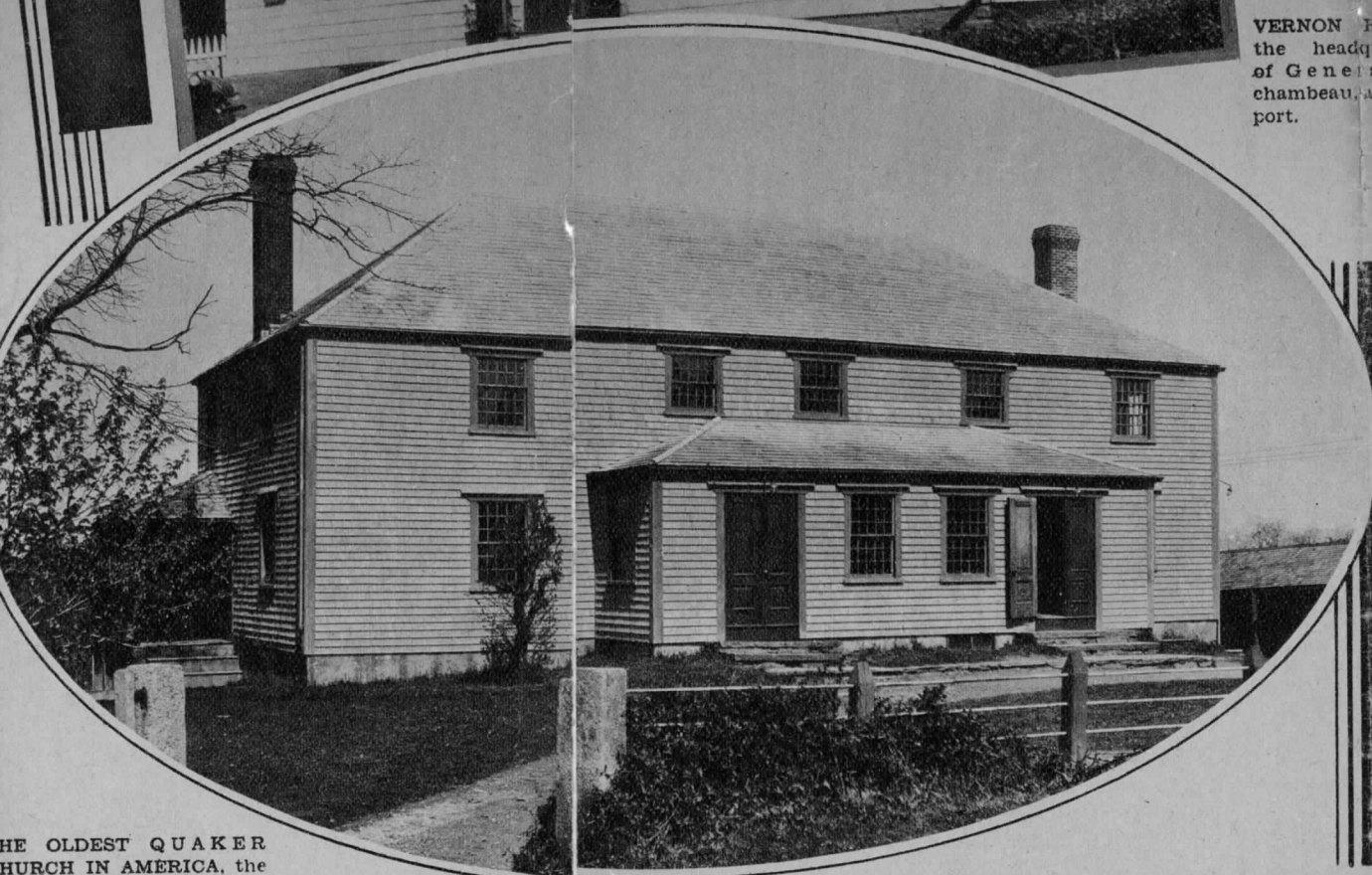

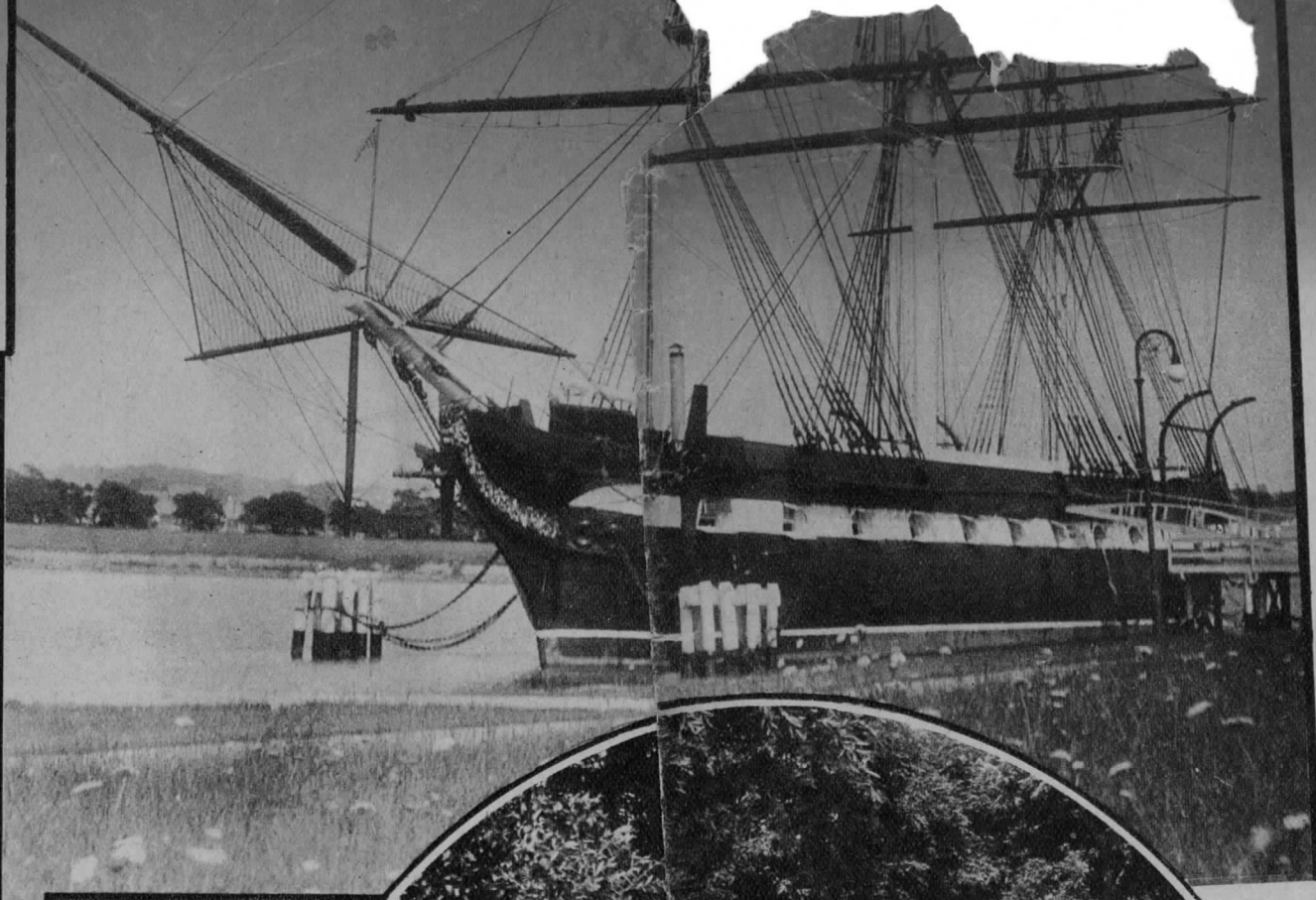

FRANK HAWKS at the finish of his remarkable East-West transcontinental flight from New York to Los Angeles in the record time of 31 hours, 50 minutes.



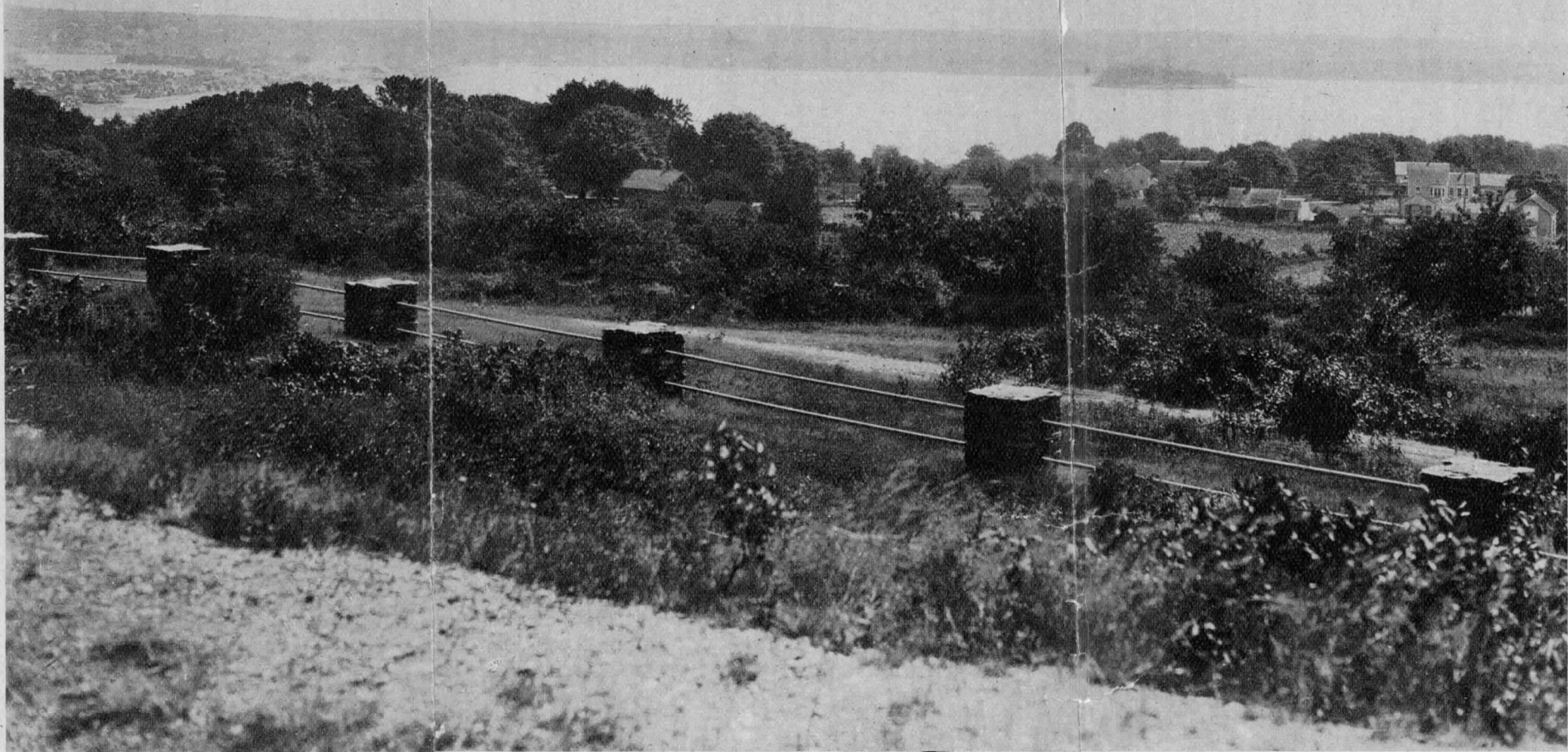
