
Coalmine Railroad Station Agent for 55 Years (1894-1939)

Portsmouth School Committee Chair for 30 years

Town Council President (1914-1917)

Mr. Anthony was born to Asa Burrington Anthony and Mary Ann Fish at the family homestead, now Connors Funeral Home.

Mr. Anthony's grandfather David Anthony owned 65 acres in the Bristol Ferry area. This home was most certainly part of his holdings. The 1860 map shows three small homes directly across from the Anthony homestead. His home is the one to the north. He was married in 1896 to Martha Elliott. This was their home until their deaths.



Frank Anthony began as station agent in 1894 and served for 55 years.

He joined the school committee in 1882 serving 53 years

He was town councilman for eight years beginning in 1908

Anthony House built in 1938 on Middle Road bears his name. It was formerly known as the Henry F. Anthony School was named for him in recognition of his many years of dedicated service on the town's school committee.
